9. Tell about the occupations of your parents (eg. What do they do? How big is the company in which they work? How long have they worked there? etc.).
10. Describe briefly your community. (eg. Location, population, economy, your community involvement and other factors.) Describe your home. (eg. Do you have your own room or do you share your room with others? Does anyone other than your parents and brothers and sisters live in it? Where in your home do you study? Where is your home in relation to your school?).
11. You will be expected to speak about your country. Tell about any speaking experience you have had before groups.
12. What other information you can give to enable a better assessment to be made of your potential as an "ambassador" for your country (Achievements, Awards, Talents
